**DIRECTIONS.**—After the number of pupils (boys and girls entered in separate columns) is filled in properly in the first vertical column for the first grade and then for the other grades, the number in each grade is to be totaled as provided opposite "Total—A;" then the number of boys under seven years of age for all the grades as recorded should appear in the proper space in the first column under "Total—D," and in like manner the number of girls under seven years of age should be totaled. By the same method the number of boys and then the number of girls of the other ages represented should be totaled in the appropriate spaces under "Total—D." "Grand Total—B" merely represents the sum total of boys and girls recorded under "Total—D." DIRECTIONS.—After the number of pupils is filled in properly in the first vertical column for the first grade and then for the other grades, the number in each grade is to be totaled as provided opposite "Total-A;" then the number of children under seven years of age for all grades as recorded should appear under "Total-B" in the proper space; in similar manner the number of children of other ages should be totaled in the appropriate spaces under "Total-B."
