DIRECTIONS.—After the number of pupils is filled in properly in the first vertical column for the first grade and then for the other grades, the number in each grade is to be totaled as provided opposite "Total-A," then the number of children under seven years of age for all grades as recorded should appear under "Total-B" in the proper space; in similar manner the number of children of other ages should be totaled in the appropriate spaces under "Total-B."
